Mary Dunkle is Senior Advisor to the National Organization for Rare Disorders (NORD<sup>®</sup>), with a primary focus on supporting the development of educational programs and resources for NORD's broad audience, including patients and caregivers, medical professionals, students and the public.

She joined NORD in 1999 and served for many years as Vice President of Communications with responsibility for the organization's website, social media, Patient/Caregiver Information Center and publications.
